**Supreme Court:** Composed of seven justices, one who serves as Chief Justice. The Justices of the Supreme Court are selected from the State at large to an 8 year term.

**Court of Appeals:** Composed of 12 positions elected by district to an 8 year term of office. (Act 1812 of 2003 created seven new electoral districts and established the dates for electing the judges within each of these districts)
