

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC is hereby given that the following popular name and ballot title for a proposed initiated act has been certified by the Arkansas Attorney General. Pursuant to Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 7, any party may contest the popular name and ballot title as an original action with the Arkansas Supreme Court after the Secretary of State has verified the petition as having the sufficient number of qualified electors' signatures to have the measure placed on the ballot at the next general election.

Notice of Certification of Sufficiency  
Pursuant to A.C.A. § 7-9-107

On June 10, 2009, this office received Opinion No. 2009-097 from the Attorney General for the State of Arkansas whereby he approved and certified a Popular Name and Ballot Title. Pursuant to A.C.A. §7-9-107 the Secretary of State shall also approve and certify the proposed Popular Name and Ballot Title as certified by the Attorney General.

Therefore, I, Charlie Daniels, Secretary of State, State of Arkansas, do hereby approve and certify the sufficiency of the following:

Popular Name

FOUR-YEAR TERMS OF OFFICE FOR COUNTY SHERIFFS, COUNTY JUDGES, COUNTY CLERKS, CIRCUIT CLERKS, COUNTY TREASURERS, COUNTY COLLECTORS OF TAXES, COUNTY ASSESSORS, COUNTY CORONERS, COUNTY SURVEYORS, AND CONSTABLES.

Ballot Title

A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT CHANGING THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR COUNTY SHERIFFS, COUNTY JUDGES, COUNTY CLERKS, CIRCUIT CLERKS, COUNTY TREASURERS, COUNTY COLLECTORS OF TAXES, COUNTY ASSESSORS, COUNTY CORONERS, COUNTY SURVEYORS, AND CONSTABLES FROM THE CURRENT TWO (2) YEARS TO FOUR (4) YEARS; MAKING THE AMENDMENT APPLICABLE TO COUNTY SHERIFFS, COUNTY JUDGES, COUNTY CLERKS, CIRCUIT CLERKS, COUNTY TREASURERS, COUNTY COLLECTORS OF TAXES, COUNTY ASSESSORS, COUNTY CORONERS, COUNTY SURVEYORS, AND CONSTABLES WHO ARE ELECTED AT THE 2010 REGULAR ELECTION AND THEREAFTER; AND REPEALING ALL PROVISIONS OF THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION IN CONFLICT WITH THE AMENDMENT.

TEXT

SECTION 1. Except as provided by Amendment 29 of the Arkansas Constitution, every person elected to the office of County Sheriff, County Judge,

County Clerk, Circuit Clerk, County Treasurer, County Collector of Taxes, County Assessor, County Coroner, County Surveyor, or Constable in this State, beginning with the regular election of 2010, shall be elected for the term of four (4) years.

SECTION 2. This amendment becomes effective upon its adoption by vote of the people at the regular election of 2010.

SECTION 3. All provisions of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas in conflict with this amendment are hereby repealed.
